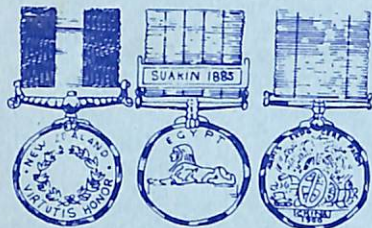

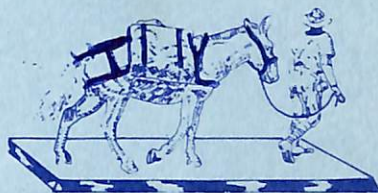
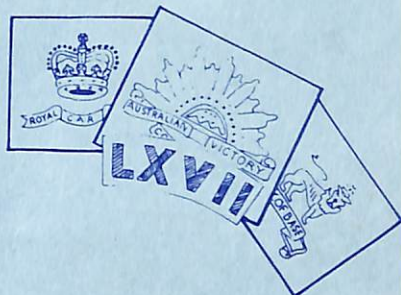

FEDERAL SECRETARY'S NOTES

This issue of Sabretache brings you the latest Directory of Members, correct to 30th March, 1974, and includes space to add amendments as advised in future issues of Sabretache. It is regretfully advised that approximately 60 names are missing from the Directory due to non-renewal of membership and as a result all members are asked to actively campaign to introduce new members.

Federal Council is endeavouring to increase membership, at present 250 financial members, to 400 by June, 1975, and so all Branch Secretaries and individual members are asked to make a real effort to achieve this number. It will be noted that the date of issues within volumes was altered with VOL XIV. Also the last issue edited

by Mr. B.J. Videon A.A.S.A. was VOL XV, No. 1. VOL XV, Nos 2 and 3, were edited by Mr. J.K. Lyons and VOL XV, No. 4, was the first issue produced by the new Federal Council in Canberra, under the editorship of Mr. J.w. Courtney.

Once again a rational approach to cross-classification has been employed where considered necessary. An asterisk (*) indicates that specific detail from within an entry has been indexed separately. Despatch items, such as important comment or discussion relating to a particular article, are referred to in brackets after the page number of the article concerned.

The increasing emphasis on book reviews has been recognised by indexing these separately for ease of reference. Titles are listed by alphabetical order of the first significant word, except in cases where several volumes of an author or publisher are reviewed together, when they are listed under the author's or publisher's name.
